Overview

WHAT?

School of Ministry is a 16-course program to train ministers, ministerial candidates and lay leaders. Each course involves reading, preparatory homework and an exciting class taught by experts in the subject matter.

WHEN?

Classes meet once a month on a Friday evening from 6:30–9:30 and Saturday from 9:00–3:00. There are eight classes each year, September–November and January–May.

WHERE?

Each class is held at the Heartland Conference Training Center in Oklahoma City at I-40 and Anderson Road. School of ministry students are entitled to stay in the conference dorms free of charge on the Friday nights during classes.

WHO?

The school is open to ministers, ministerial candidates and lay leaders alike. There are no formal academic requirements for admission to the school, but a pastoral recommendation is required.

WHY?

The school provides most of the educational requirements for ministerial licensing in the Heartland Conference and provides a fundamental course of study to strengthen lay leaders for ministry. Through an agreement with Advantage College, School of Ministry graduates can earn an Associates of Arts in Christian Ministry with the addition of two or three classes. Also, SCU accepts some of our classes along with life experience in their ABLE program.
